- If you are writing letters for pilgrims, please put their full name on the envelope as some pilgrims have the same first name. Letters should be there on Thursday, but at the latest, on Saturday night. The ALD and ASD give the report Saturday night at candlelight and if the pilgrim does not have 12 letters by then, they will announce that the pilgrim needs additional letters. The letters are sorted and put in boxes Sunday morning.

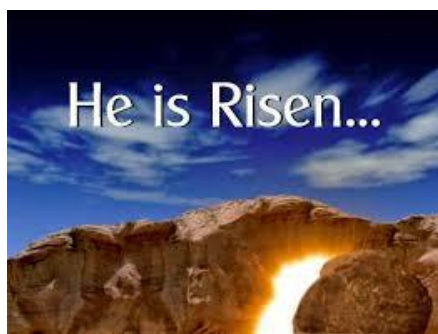

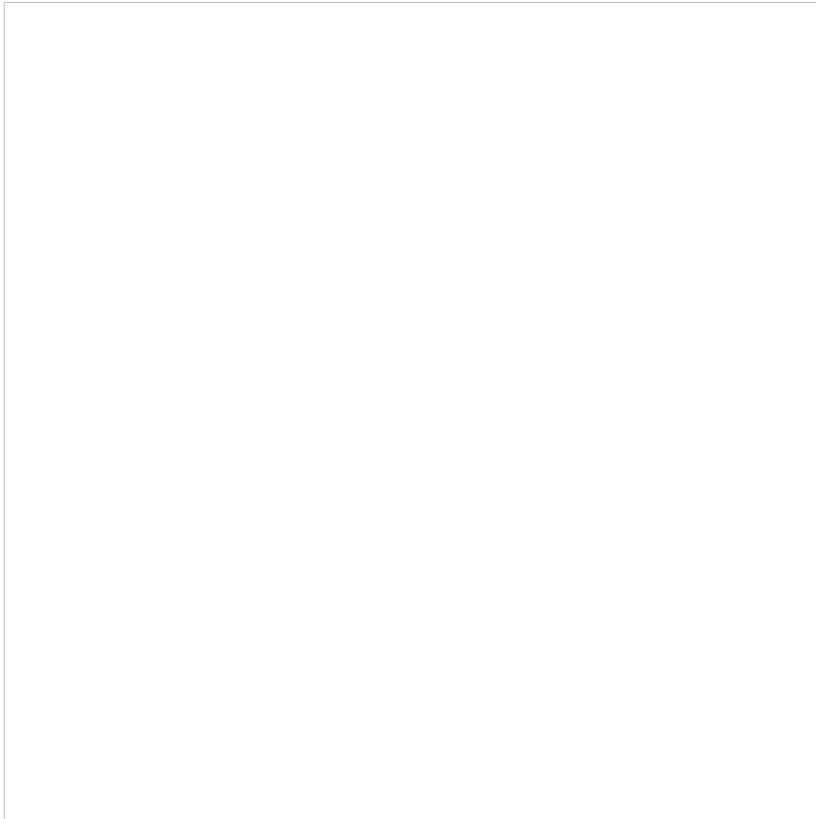

Greeting High Plains Emmaus Community;

It is hard to believe it is already August. Where has the year gone? My teacher friends, grandkids, and your kids too, I'm sure, are wondering where summer vacation went; while mothers are

celebrating the start of a new school year. As our children begin a new school year we all need to be diligent in praying for their safety and that every one has a wonderful school year.

I can't help but notice that HPE walks are not filling up as quickly as they did years ago and it is now unheard of to ever have 10 or 12 on the waiting list. I understand that as we get bigger and have more people go on walks the pool gets smaller. However, economics is another point to take in consideration. If you have someone in mind that would benefit from a walk experience (and who wouldn't?) and you would not be able to pay the walk fees this could be a solution.

Here are just a few reminders about sponsoring a pilgrim:

- Years ago when our Emmaus Community began, almost all pilgrims paid their own pilgrim fee. As time went on, some sponsors started paying for their pilgrims fee and it became the norm after a while. While it is a wonderful and generous idea to pay for your pilgrim's fee, it is not a requirement of the sponsor to pay. Many pilgrims are able and more than willing to pay to go on a Walk and there is even some thought that if pilgrims pay their own fee, they are more apt to go on the Walk if they have a personal investment in it.

- There are some people that are willing to pay for a pilgrim to go on a Walk, but they are not willing to be the one to actually sponsor someone and do the work involved in sponsoring someone. If you are one of these people, please contact one of the Registrars and let them know and they can connect you with someone that needs some help financially sponsoring a pilgrim.

- Many reunion groups have helped to sponsor pilgrims-when you have several people contributing, it helps to defray the expense.

- Remember that each walk has 3 \$50 scholarships that are available. They are on a first come first serve basis-just ask the Registrar if there are scholarships available.

- If you would like to sponsor someone, but do not have the funds to do so, contact the Registrars or someone on the board and see if they know of someone that would be willing to help.

- If you have any questions about sponsoring, please contact anyone on the board, the Registrars or Patty Mohon, who does sponsor training in our Community. We want to continue to bless people with the gift of going on Emmaus Walks and good sponsorship is vital!

NEVER be afraid to ask for help or to ask questions if you are unsure about what sponsorship involves. It is such a blessing to serve the most awesome, best ever community in the world!

Greetings High Plains Community-

I would like to thank Hillside Christian Church for hosting our November meeting and thank you to Greg Jennings for doing the Fourth Day talk. We so appreciate churches who are willing to have Community meetings and those who are willing to give Fourth Day talks.

After considerable discussion and prayer, High Plains Emmaus Board of Directors voted several month ago to increase walk fees for all pilgrims and team members by \$10. This means the walk fees will now be \$175. This increase in fees has raised some concern among some community members and there have been questions about where walk fee money is spent. Following is a break down of where the walk fee money is used:

\$140-paid to the ARK for lodging and meals

\$13-Upper Room

\$7-Name tag

\$5-lanyard cross

\$1.50-purple worship book

\$167.50

The \$7.50 that remains is applied toward the walk fees for Clergy. The Board voted many years ago to pay Clergy fees as they might work 2 or as many as 3 walks a year and often clergy have to pay someone to fill their pulpit for the Sunday they are at the Ark ministering to the pilgrims. The last couple of years, several of the walks have not been filled; some walks have been short as many as 10 pilgrims. When this occurs, the Board does not have enough money for pilgrim and team fees to cover expenses. I hope this answers any questions you had about the increase in fee cost. Rest assured the Board will continue work hard to make sure walks continue to be as reasonably priced as possible.

We would like to congratulate Rick Chandler, Jimmy Glascock, Jena Rush, Mary Lou Kropp and James Robbins for being elected to serve on the High Plains Emmaus board. Thank you to all who were willing to run for the board.

Praying that each and every one of you and yours have a safe and blessed Christmas Season and join together to celebrate the miracle of the birth of Jesus, our Lord and Savior.
